Week 2: Principles of antitrust law and economics. Competition and market structure. Network industries.

Week 3: Two- and multi-sided markets.

Week 4: Sharing economy.

Week 5: Essential facility doctrine in EU and U.S..

Week 6: Regulation vs. antitrust: lessons from *Trinko*. The margin squeeze in EU and U.S..

Week 7: Telecommunications regulation.

Week 8: Net neutrality and spectrum rights.

Week 9: Transport regulation: Railways.

Week 10: Airlines and slot allocation.

Week 11: Regulation of the biopharmaceutical industry.
